Enable harmonisation, interoperability and long-term access across repositories, to strengthen federation of TDRs within EOSC




Upskill of Trustworthy Digital Repositories [within the network] and expansion of the network through training, support and mentoring programmes

### Strengthened FAIR Capabilities and Trustworthiness

Improved the repositories' ability to support FAIR principles via training, peer-support and financial aid. Essential TDR Characteristics defined through the Transparent Trustworthy Repository Attributes Matrix (TTRAM)

European cross-disciplinary Trustworthy Digital Repositories engaged in a network to provide a common voice and collective support to TDRs.
