

# Towards a European network of FAIR-enabling Trustworthy Digital Repositories.

## Main goals

-  Establish, develop, and operate a European network of trustworthy digital repositories within the EOSC ecosystem
-  Enable harmonisation, interoperability and long-term access across repositories, to strengthen federation of TDRs within EOSC
-  Upskill of Trustworthy Digital Repositories [within the network] and expansion of the network through training, support and mentoring programmes

## Main impacts



### Strengthened FAIR Capabilities and Trustworthiness

Improved the repositories' ability to support FAIR principles via training, peer-support and financial aid. Essential TDR Characteristics defined through the Transparent Trustworthy Repository Attributes Matrix (TTRAM).



### Establishment of the European Network of TDRs

European cross-disciplinary Trustworthy Digital Repositories engaged in a network to provide a common voice and collective support to TDRs.



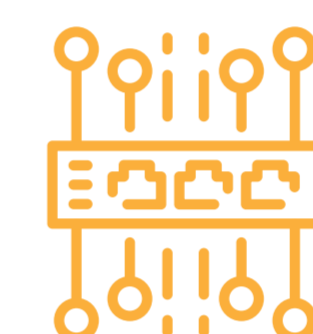
### Interoperability across Repositories
