Main project goals

- Establish, develop, and operate a European network of trustworthy digital repositories within the EOSC ecosystem
- Enable harmonisation, interoperability and long-term access across repositories, to strengthen federation of TDRs within EOSC
- Upskill of Trustworthy Digital Repositories [within the network] and expansion of the network through training, support and mentoring programmes

A "common voice" for European repositories

Trustworthy Digital Repositories are a key enabler of the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC) ambition to sustain a web of FAIR data. With the establishment of a vibrant and self-sustaining European Network of TDRs we ensure common needs and various types of support are provided.



Co-development of the FIDELIS TDR Network

The provisional members shape the Network's governance, including different membership tiers. Alongside membership, the provisional members also define how the Network aligns and collaborates with other organisations.



Access to tailored training and mentoring opportunities for digital repositories

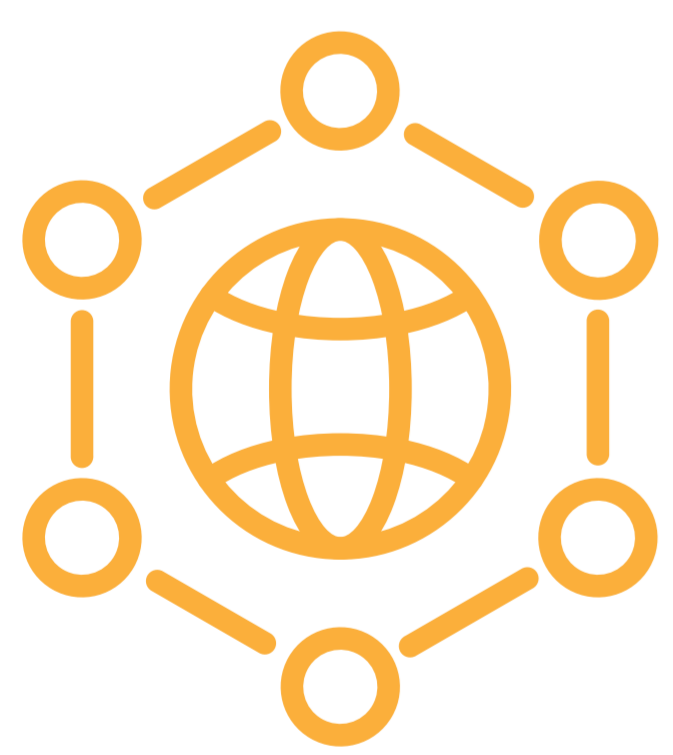
